V. SCHOOL AND CHILDCARE HOT TOPICS – Alyson Cram

- ❖ School Vaccine Compliance Changes
- ❖ Fall assessment results were discussed
- ❖ Uninsured children may go to the County Care Clinics for immunizations. If they have insurance they must go to their provider
- ❖ Send in all Medical Exemptions (Alyson will forward them to Dr. Kaiser)
- ❖ Medical Exemptions from out of State are still acceptable; they must be signed by a M.D. or D.O.
- ❖ A school or childcare cannot accept future appointments as documentation of vaccinations

VI. IMMUNIZATIONS ACROSS THE LIFESPAN – Alice Holguin

- **National Immunization Awareness Month (NAIM) Overview**
Discussion centered around activities completed during NAIM and ideas for the future

- ❖ **WEEK 1 – A healthy start begins with on-time vaccination remind parents to Immunize their children (Promote)**
 1. Reminder Recall conducted to remind patients of upcoming immunization appointments or missed appointments
 2. Screening for immunizations done at each patients visit decreasing missed opportunities to vaccinate
 3. Parents called when appointments are missed to reschedule
 4. Extra events planned to promote immunizations for children
- ❖ **WEEK 2 – Protect yourself & pass protection on to your baby**
 1. Educational items specific to vaccines for pregnant women were distributed
 2. Reminders sent to pregnant moms to get Tdap & Flu shots
 3. Flyers were delivered to OBGYN provider offices
- ❖ **WEEK 3 – Vaccines are not just for kids**
 1. Health events were held focusing on adult immunizations
 2. Reminded adults they need the flu shot at non vaccine related appointments
 3. Health promotions were done for employees reminding them that health care workers need vaccines as well and vaccines were offered to employees
 4. Mobile clinics were made available to offer vaccines
- ❖ **WEEK 4 – Ensure a healthy future with vaccines**
 1. Reminder recall phone calls were done to remind parents about upcoming immunizations
 2. Team up with other organizations to give the flu shot
 3. Clinics were conducted at schools to offer students the immunizations they would need to be compliant with vaccines required for school
